



## **Meet the Street - II** **Questions for Interviews**

### ➤ **Education**

1. What are your thoughts on introducing European studies to your education? Why?
2. What do you think/how do you feel about your educational system? Is there any changes needed? What changes would you make? What do you know about other educational systems in other countries?
3. Do you think learning languages is important? When should you start learning a second language? How many languages do you learn at school? Is it compulsory?
4. Do you think school should be compulsory? How many years the school should be compulsory?
5. In which country do you live? How much does 1 year at university cost in your country? Is further education financially accessible to you? Why?
6. What is your opinion towards Erasmus projects? In which country would you like to study?
7. Are you aware of getting other education opportunities abroad? Do you think there is enough exchange programmes? Do you receive information?

### ➤ **Employment**

8. How did you find your 1<sup>st</sup> job? (student job or real work)
9. What is would be your dream job? What are you doing to achieve it? Do you think it is possible to combine your passion with what you do?
10. Are there any possibilities for job seekers at your school?
11. What are the opportunities to find a job in your area?
12. Are there any experiences for working abroad?
13. Do you think that women and men should have equal pay and the same opportunities in their job? What do you think about this?
14. Should the state give less money to young people who don't work/don't have a job? Why?

### ➤ **Health**

15. What could/should be done to prevent youngsters from getting eating disorders?
16. What do you do to keep yourself healthy? What should you do to keep yourself healthy?
17. How much do you know about prevention of HIV/AIDS and teenage pregnancy?
18. How do you feel about soft drugs and hard drugs? How accessible are drugs to you?
19. If you had an addiction to alcohol or drugs do you know where you could find help?
20. Do you think alcohol is necessary for you to have fun and a good time when you go out?

#### ➤ **Health**

21. In some European countries, euthanasia or abortion are legal, what is your opinion about this? If you were politician what should be the law about euthanasia in your country?
22. What do you think is the best age to buy alcohol? At which age did you buy alcohol the first time?
23. What do you think is a good age to buy cigarettes? When did you buy some the first time?

#### ➤ **Local Institutions**

24. Where do you feel safe/ comfortable? Why do you feel safe there? Do you feel safe in your country? Where do you not feel safe?
25. Is there one particular place where you spend your free time?
26. If you could change one thing in your city, what would it be? What would you like politicians/youngsters to do/change in your country?

#### ➤ **Media**

27. How does the media influence you the most? Is the media influential to your society? Do you have positive role models?

#### ➤ **Immigration**

28. Because of our growing multi-cultural societies, do you think schools should teach more around racism? Do you think immigrants feel welcome in our society? What can we do to make them feel more accepted?
29. Do you think/feel you are part of the European Community? How could you feel more connected to Europe?
30. How is it possible to make youth policies more relevant to the youth? How can we bridge the gap between politics and people?
31. Do you think it is important to vote? Do you feel pressured into voting?
